

International Program Refund Policy

In the event that a student does not come to Canada or decides not to attend or to leave Abbotsford School District's International Program, the following terms will apply:

- a. The application fee is non-refundable in any circumstances.
- b. All refunds are subject to a \$200 processing fee.
- c. For students in their first year of participation in the International Programs, the following will apply:
 - i. the full program fee, less the application fee and the refund processing fee, will be refunded upon receipt of satisfactory evidence that the Study Permit was not approved by Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC);
 - ii. two-thirds (2/3) of the program fee, less the application fee and the refund processing fee, will be refunded if the student withdraws prior to commencement of program;
 - iii. one half (1/2) of the program fee, less the application fee and the refund processing fee, will be refunded if the student withdraws within the first calendar month of commencing the program; and
- d. No refund will be provided:
 - i. for any reason, if the student withdraws after the first calendar month of the program
 - ii. if a student is dismissed from the program because of a violation of the International Student Agreement
 - iii. if any information in the student's application for admission is untrue
 - iv. if the student breaches any of the obligations set up in the paragraph 1 in the International Student Agreement
 - v. if the student is unable to perform or is not performing to a reasonable academic standard (grade level of less than C- or equivalent)
 - vi. if the School District is unable to provide an educational program as a result of any labour dispute
